AT HEIGHT TRAINING

Fall Protection Rescue (Basic Rescue)

This training course is designed for any supervisor or personnel who works at heights in construction or general industry. This course teaches the basics of self rescue as well as assisting a fall victim. CONFINED SPACE

Confined Space & Confined Space Entry Training

This advanced multi-media based course is designed for individuals responsible for confined space entry or for planning and supervising employees who work in confined spaces. The course provides a detailed look at confined space regulations, the typical hazards involved, and a variety of control measures. The session also includes a number of hands-on exercises focusing on rescue, equipment application, maintenance and inspection, as well as instrumentation calibration.

OSHA 3110: Fall Arrest Systems

This course provides an overview of state-of-the-art technology for fall protection and current OSHA requirements. Topics covered include the principles of fall protection, the components of fall arrest systems, the limitations of fall arrest equipment, and OSHA policies regarding fall protection. Course features a one-day field exercise demonstrating fall protection equipment. Personal Protective Equipment: Safety shoes, safety glasses, and appropriate clothing for field exercise. 1.9 CEU's; credits to be assessed.
